IMPORTANT FEE INFORMATION CHANGES FOR STUDENTS

For the 2015-16 academic year, there is a new fee payment process deadline.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

There are some important changes happening to Ontario College fee payments. This follows the Government of Ontario's tuition and ancillary fee billing practices.

Instead of having a per-semester OASP deposit and fee payment deadline, there is now a one-time deposit date with per-semester fee payment deadlines. The one-time deposit deadline is June 15th, 2015.

The balances of fees are to be paid on the fee deadlines, as follows:

- Fall fees due Friday, August 14, 2015
- Winter fees due Friday, December 4, 2015
- Spring fees due Friday, April 15, 2016

HOW MUCH DO I NEED TO PAY?

The one-time deposit is \$500.00 and is applied directly to your student account toward your tuition fees. There are two exceptions:

1. If you are on OSAP or Second Career funding you pay a \$200 deposit.
2. If you are a sponsored student you do not pay a deposit.

There are no deferral fees.

IS THERE A LATE FEE?

If you do not pay the deposit by June 15th, a late fee will be applied to your fees. Late fees are \$150.00. You may also be charged a late fee if you do not pay your winter fees by December 4th.
