## **Priority #1 Organizational Excellence**

#### Goal:

Increase organizational capacity to effectively meet the needs of Aboriginal learners

- 1.1 Establish an Aboriginal Centre of Excellence responsible for the overall strategic development and evolution of Aboriginal education
- 1.2 Maximize the Native Education and Training Council's working relationship with the Board of Governors and Senior Administration
- 1.3 Ensure that institutional human resource practices are inclusive and reflective of the Aboriginal community
- 1.4 Increase institutional awareness of the unique needs and challenges of Aboriginal students attending post-secondary
- 1.5 Increase Aboriginal-content and course offerings

## **Priority #2 Access to Education**

#### Goal:

Achieve a 25% Aboriginal student enrolment rate

- 2.1 Ensure equitable access to post-secondary educational opportunities for Aboriginal learners
- 2.2 Increase collaborative and academic partnerships with First Nations, colleges and universities that promote pathways and transitions
- 2.3 Address financial barriers for Aboriginal learners
- 2.4 Promote education as a viable and realistic option for Aboriginal community members

### **Priority # 3 Aboriginal Student Success**

#### Goa

Increase Aboriginal student retention rates

- 3.1 Provide access to culturally-relevant supports and activities
- 3.2 Provide effective academic supports that meet the needs of Aboriginal learners
