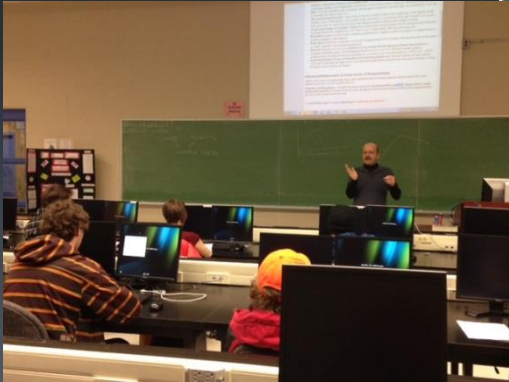

What is Dual Credit?

- 1 COURSE = 2 CREDITS
 - You Receive a College Credit
 - &
 - A High School Elective Credit



What is Dual Credit ?

- You can choose from a variety of COLLEGE courses taken after 3:00pm
 - The course you choose is FREE
 - Textbooks and other materials are all covered and FREE to you!



What is Dual Credit?

- All college courses you complete will be on your College Transcript and you will NOT have to take that course again once enrolled in College



COLLEGE

- University Bound?
 - Some College courses transfer
 - also looks good on a University application!



Why Take a Dual Credit?

- Earn an extra High School Credit (You may be behind or want to get ahead)
- Experience what a college class is like
- Get exposed to a possible career (You may love it or hate it)
- A new challenge and experience
- Get a head start on your College education
- It is FREE (You can take up to 4 Dual Credit Classes)

Student Services

Summer Dual Credit

- Take a summer course – Like Summer school but in college.
- Morning and Afternoon classes available

- You can achieve 2 high school credits and 1 college credit in 6 weeks!
- Same as regular Dual Credit – All the assistance and support is here for you!!
