- Assist with paint touch up and final product dealing and cleaning
- Ensure that all work is performed in accordance with Company quality standards, policies & procedures and Regulatory Authority requirements (TC, FAA, etc.).
- Report any quality issues to the supervisor or team lead
- Perform any other duties within the company to support operational requirements.

- Ability to use tools, equipment, and materials in the aircraft paint stripping process and paint preparation process
