Responsibilities

- Use TruNorth recorded data to analyze the life cycle of Chaga and help plan harvest schedules to ensure the sustainability of the species and better understand the understudied lifecycle of Chaga as a species and its correlation with its environment
- Collaborate with forest management companies and MNR to share data, harvest areas for safety, efficiency, sustain the environment
- Monitor TruNorth Chaga harvesters, old harvest locations using GIS programs to track annual schedules ensuring regenerative growth of the fungi and its environment are secured.

- Complete and submit Natural Health Product applications to health Canada or similar certifying bodies with the US & Europe.
