- . Transcribing/editing dictated reports through the M\*Modal dictation system in the absence of a Health Information Management Assistant or when required to ensure turnaround times are met
- . Proficient in Meditech applications ADM, ITS, MRI, EMR, Scanning and Archiving and E.chart; M\*Modal
- . Quantitative and Qualitative Analysis of charts
- . Process requests related to access and/or disclosure of personal health information (PHI) according to NSHN Privacy Policy, Information and Privacy Commission (IPC) of Ontario and other applicable provincial statutes and legislation
- .
