The Opportunity: Note: this position is located in Blind River. A Youth Worker to provide support and mentoring to youth with barriers aged 15 to 29 years old who are seeking employment opportunities. The incumbent will regularly meet with the youth to review needs and create action plans for a successful transition to employment or other goals and provide mentoring and follow-up based on the action plan. The incumbent will also meet with community agencies' staff for the purposes of marketing and referral as well as to develop mentoring opportunities. The incumbent will assist with employer outreach, matching and monitoring. The Youth Worker will arrange for or deliver relevant workshops, materials, and job clubs for job seekers, and will work closely with the Employment Ontario consulting and placement staff as required.

This is a regular part-time support staff position, 24 hours/week, \$22.81/hour.
