Garden River First Nation Child & Family Services is seeking a Community Outreach Worker to be responsible for providing education and support to various target groups to improve life skills to build a strong community for our children and families. Education/support are provided by facilitating a wide range of evidence-based primary and secondary prevention programs and strategies to address risk factors experienced by children, youth, and parents; and collaborate on the planning/implementation of community activities and programs to promote physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual wellness. The Community Outreach Worker functions within legislative requirements, regulations, policies and procedures and the Mission, Beliefs and Vision of the Garden River First Nation Child and Family Services department and contributes to the accomplishment of the strategic priorities.

DUTIES

- Delivering age specific and culturally appropriate services/programs to the children/youth/parents of the community by:
- Developing and/or modifying relevant and age specific and culturally appropriate curriculum and resources;
- Implementing curriculum/resources through workshops and/or circles at various sites within the community and/or in homes;
- Using a variety of teaching techniques including modeling, observing, questioning, demonstrating and reinforcing to promote healthy lifestyles;
- Educate, encourage and support participants to practice self-help skills;
- Actively promote healthy choices, habits and lifestyles by providing participants with appropriate resources and materials;
- Planning and carrying out program activities which facilitate an understanding of our Indigenous culture, language and value system in relation to healthy lifestyles;
- Working with other professionals in developing specific programs/resources for children, youth and parents as appropriate;
- Completing administrative tasks;
- Perform other related duties as may be required and assigned

Required Skills

- Required Post-Secondary Diploma in Community Services, or a related field;
- Required a minimum six months related experience;
- Experience with group presentation and facilitation experience;
- Knowledge and interest in issues affecting Indigenous people;
- Demonstrated sensitivity to and knowledge of the First Nation cultural values and traditions;
- Excellent knowledge of the resources and services provided both internally/externally to the Community;
- Excellent facilitation, coordination, assessment and planning skills;
- Ability to work flexible hours including after hour and weekend support;

- Ability to work under pressure to meet deadlines;
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively as a member of a team;
