- Document students' progress/learning objectives and provide comments to the classroom teacher for reporting purposes (i.e., report cards).
- Participate in the development of classroom resources to enhance student learning in accordance with learning objectives.
- Participate in all Biidaaban Kinoomaagegamik professional development opportunities.
- Follow Biidaaban Kinoomaagegamik calendar holidays for the school term.
- Advance with assigned students each year by grade level.
