REQUIREMENTS

Academic: To be admissible to study full-time at the College, the equivalent of a Secondary School Diploma at the College preparation level or higher is needed. Some programs require further studies. Students are required to be at least 18 years old by the end of their first semester. To study in a graduate certificate program, you will need a high school diploma plus a College or University diploma or degree.

English Language Proficiency for Diploma and College Certificate Programs: TOEFL score of 79-80 for the internet based test (iBT) and no test below 20 OR IELTS Academic score of 6.0 with no bans lower than 5.5 OR Duolingo 110.

English Language Proficiency for Graduate Certificate and Bachelor Degree Programs: TOEFL score of 88 for the internet based test (iBT) and no test below 21 OR IELTS Academic score of 6.5 with no bands lower than 6.0 OR Duolingo 120.
